

## **DRAMA STUDIO 2022**

Applications are now open for this year's Drama Studio course. The closing date is Friday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2022.

Before you apply, remember we do not accept applications from students on a full-time course.

We will get back in touch with you later in the year to invite you to audition for the course. There are 2 stages:

**Round 1:** Individual sessions lasting 15 minutes, held on Friday 19th & Saturday 20th August 2022. If you are not free on these dates, we may be able to see you on a different day. It's worth asking!

You should prepare 2 contrasting excerpts from published plays, each one lasting **2 minutes or less**. One piece should be classical (for example, Shakespeare). We will ask you to perform these to a panel of 2-3 people. We might film them to help us make decisions later. Please be prepared to talk about your choice of audition piece and why you have applied to the course.

Please deliver your pieces in your own native accent!

**Round 2:** If we'd like to see you again, we'll ask you to come along to a 3 hour group workshop. There are usually around 14 people in the group. It will be held on Saturday 27th August 2022.

Unfortunately we are unable to offer alternative dates for this stage.

The course will begin on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2022 and will run on Saturdays from 10am until 6pm and on Wednesday evenings until Saturday 17th December 2022. You must be free to attend every session.

Some further information for you:

- If you are offered a place, you will be asked to sign a contract. Please ask if you would like to see a sample contract in advance.
- There is a non-refundable fee of £150 for those who accept a place. This is to cover the cost of processing applications, auditions and administration, but the weekly workshops are currently provided free-of-charge. The first instalment (£75) is due before the course starts and the second before half-term.
- There is no guarantee you will progress to the production in 2023, nor are you required to do so.
- If you are currently registered with an agent, you must discuss your application with them first.
- The Lyric Theatre does not bear any responsibility to promote individual participants on the course.
