WHAT IS DRAMA STUDIO?

Drama Studio is a 14 week training programme for 18-26 year olds, delivered by the Creative Learning team at the Lyric Theatre, Northern Ireland's only full time producing theatre.

The Lyric was founded by Mary O'Malley in 1951 and from the very beginning Mary championed the importance of drama involvement for young people. In 1979, together with Sam McCready, they set up Drama Studio and described it as a 'proper training ground for young actors who hope to enter the world of professional theatre.'

Today, Drama Studio remains a flagship project at the Lyric as we support young people through a prestigious training course and provide performance opportunities in a full scale production, as well as assisting with audition preparation and financial support through theatre bursaries. This level of all-round support makes Drama Studio the only course of its kind within the UK.

As there are currently no full-time actor training courses available in Northern Ireland, Drama Studio helps bridge that gap.

Over 85 Drama Studio students have gone on to major Drama Schools, many of which have successful careers as working actors such as Anthony Boyle (Harry Potter & the Cursed Child, Masters of the Air, House of Guinness), Desmond Eastwood (Normal People, In the Land of Saints and Sinners, Blue Lights) and Katherine Devlin (Blue Lights) who has referred to Drama Studio as “a really fantastic system for people that are auditioning for drama school”. Many more former members now work very successfully in a variety of roles within the creative industries.

WHAT WILL YOU STUDY?

During the 14 week programme, you will be fully immersed in the world of theatre, receiving professional-level training from experienced industry facilitators from all over Ireland and the UK, such as RADA and Royal Shakespeare Company. You'll receive a comprehensive introduction to the methods of some of the greatest practitioners in theatre, such as Stanislavski, Chekov, and Meisner. The course covers essential disciplines such as stage & screen acting, movement, voice coaching and more, all delivered in a fast-paced, intensive environment.

It also includes other workshops aimed at enhancing your work as a professional actor, giving you a head start in your career. Examples include stage combat, budgeting and media training.

It's ideal for those ready to commit, work hard, and grow rapidly—what you put in truly shapes what you get out.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Age: 18-26 years old (at the time of applying).

Requirements: You cannot apply if you are in full-time education. Due to the high demand for the programme, we do ask that all participants are available to attend each session of the programme.

Qualifications: There are no formal qualifications required to apply for the course.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

Once the programme is complete, you will have the opportunity to audition for the annual Lyric Drama Studio Production on the Naughton Stage. Involvement in the production is a hugely exciting opportunity to work with industry professionals and is the ultimate work experience for aspiring professional actors.

The cast will work with all departments within our producing house, including costume, lighting and sound design, stage management and technical production.

Participation in the show will count as professional credit.

September - December

PRODUCTION IN THE NAUGHTON STUDIO:

Rehearsals - January - April

Tuesday & Wednesday evenings from 7pm - 9:30pm

Saturday from 10am - 5:30pm

Full time rehearsals - The week before the performance

Production - April/May - 2 week run



SELECTION & AUDITION PROCESS

THERE ARE 2 STAGES TO OUR AUDITION PROCESS, BOTH HELD IN AUGUST:

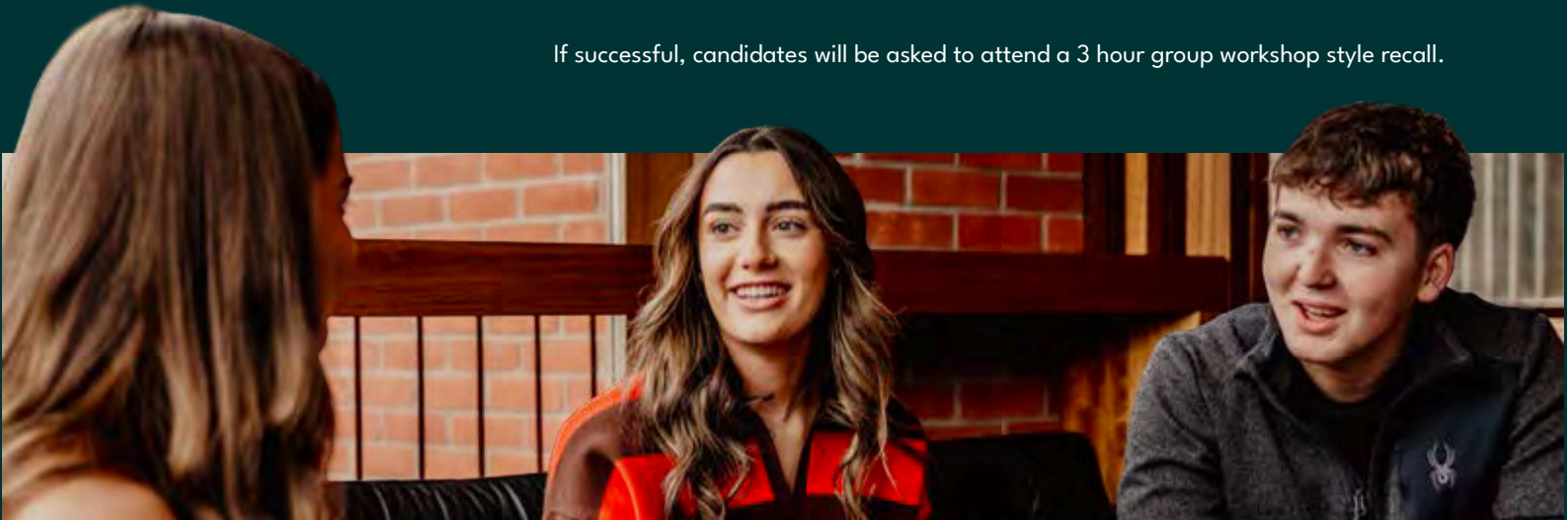
ROUND 1: INDIVIDUAL AUDITION.

Auditionees will be asked to prepare 2 contrasting excerpts from published plays (one contemporary and one classical), each one lasting 2 minutes or less.

Candidates will be asked to perform these to a panel from the Lyric Theatre. Once complete, there will be a short discussion about the choice of audition piece and why you have applied to the course. The overall audition will last for 15 minutes.

ROUND 2 - RECALLS.

If successful, candidates will be asked to attend a 3 hour group workshop style recall.





TUITION FEES

Fee: £200

This can be paid all at once or in two installments.

Thanks to the generous support of our partners, we're proud to offer one of the most affordable, high-quality actor training programmes in the UK.

Our fee is heavily subsidised by the Lyric Theatre, Arts Council of NI & Belfast City Council.

ALUMNI SUPPORT - BURSARIES

Once the course is complete, the Lyric continues to support Drama Studio alumni in a number of ways.

Bursaries are available to support young people from Northern Ireland accessing pathways in theatre, primarily in the areas of performing.

'The Lyric- Fishmongers Theatre Bursary' offers up to 5 bursaries of £4,000, available each year to past and present members of Drama Studio who are currently studying, or about to begin studying, in an actor training programme in the UK and Ireland.

Additionally, smaller bursaries are also provided to support participants travelling to Drama School auditions as well as, assisting with costs for headshots, equipment, books required for study and assisting with general living expenses while training.
